

Prosciutto Wrapped Asparagus Appetizer

Whether you are having a formal family gathering or just a casual gettogether with friends, these prosciutto wrapped asparagus spears are the perfect appetizer that everyone will love. Not only are they quick and simple to make, but they look just as good as they taste! The best part is asparagus is a finger food, which means less dishes!

Ingredients

Bunch of asparagus (trimmed and tougher lower stem removed) - thick stems work best

100-200 grams prosciutto (sliced in half horizontally)

Olive oil for drizzling

Parmesan cheese for sprinkling Fresh ground pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Line baking sheet with parchment paper.

One stalk at a time, wrap prosciutto snugly around asparagus and place

on baking sheet.

Drizzle olive oil evenly across wrapped asparagus and sprinkle with parmesan cheese and pepper.

Bake for 15-20 minutes, or until asparagus is tender. Remove from oven and allow to stand for 5-10 minutes before serving. Enjoy!

Red Berry Vodka Soda


