Tourtière

A traditional part of the Christmas réveillon and New Year's Eve meal in Quebec, but that doesn't stop everyone from enjoying this fine dish.

Ingredients

1 lb lean ground pork (may use 1/2 beef)
 1 onion (small) chopped
 1/4 tsp. Poultry seasoning
 1/4 tsp. Sage
 1 1/2 tsp. salt
 Dash of cloves
 Pepper to taste
 1/4 cup rolled oats (approx.)

Combine first seven ingredients.
 add water to cover



cook slowly, stirring once in a while, especially at the beginning when done, remove from stove add about 1/4 cup rolled oats to thicken
 Cool a few minutes, turn into a pastry lined pie pan
 moisten edges of lower crust with water
 Press edges together, trim off excess pastry
 Cut a designer for steam vents
 bake in a hot oven (375 degree F) for about 40 minutes or until crust is light browned
 Serve, M-M-M good !
